OBJECTIVES:

- The objective of this checklist is to verify compliance to the Criteria listed in the Sabah Legality Standard as defined by Principles 1 4 for Sabah dated November 2020 (SFD-TLAS-002).
- Compliance is defined when all applicable criteria are observed to be compliant. A Minor Gap to any indicator does not constitute non-compliance to a criterion. A Major Gap to any applicable indicator does reflect non-compliance to a criterion. Compliance for a criterion where multiple minor gaps are identified in indicators under the criterion may reflect non-compliance to the criterion.
- All issues identified under this standard shall be considered appropriate to the scale and degree of forestry operations undertaken by the parties under the agreement.

Summary Information

Overview of Licensee:

- Sabah State Government, through the Sabah Forestry Department, has awarded an area of 10,018.3 hectares within the Sapulut Forest Reserve to Pesona Majukaya Sdn. Bhd. (Pesona Majukaya) under the Sustainable Forest Management License Agreement (SFMLA) No. 01/2018 for FMU 25. The SFMLA was made on 20/04/2018 and is valid for 100 years until 31/12/2117.
- On 26/07/2021, the SFD issued a Coupe Permit for the area allowing Pesona Majukaya to implement planned activities until 19/04/2068.

- Pesona Majukaya is also affiliated with Top Quantum Sdn. Bhd., First Greenworld Sdn. Bhd., Zillion Fortune Sdn. Bhd., & Empayar Kejora Sdn. Bhd., which comes under the auspices of Rakan Rimba Sdn. Bhd
- Pesona Majukaya has appointed contractors to conduct the salvage logging inside the licensed area, namely, Vivadaya Sdn. Bhd., SSK Enterprise, Datsing Sdn. Bhd. and Zat Istimewa Sdn. Bhd.
- The RIL harvesting contractor is yet to be appointed, whereas the CHP document is prepared by Rakan Rimba Sdn. Bhd.
- The previous assessment was conducted in December 2022 that resulted in 2 gap(s) and 2 observation(s) (Report #: GFSSBH003-170).

Current Operations:

- Pesona Majukaya only focuses on salvage logging inside ITP couped areas, with a total timber production of 39,562.88 m³ projected for the first quarter of 2023.
- Pesona Majukaya has an approved CHP document for Compartment 15 in 2023 (Ref. #: JPHTN/FRM-CHP:700-3/9/33-1/JLD.1/3, dated 16/01/2023). The RIL harvesting activities are expected to commence in 2023. As of June 2023, no RIL harvesting has commenced.
- Pesona Majukaya has yet to commence the planting inside the ITP couped areas.

Environmental Context:

- Sapulut Forest Reserve was the most remote region of the Tawau District before a road was
 constructed in 1982. Sapulut Forest Reserve was gazetted as a commercial forest reserve on
 18th January 1979. Prior to SFM, logging operations in Sapulut FR were divided into working
 blocks of various sizes and shapes with short-term logging licenses, which comprise Special
 License (usually more than 5 years) and Form 1 License employing conventional harvesting
 method with a felling diameter of >60cm DBH.
- The FMU consists of regenerating logged-over forests. In the lower-lying areas in the north, where logging was extensive and poor logging practices in the past had reduced the vegetation to a secondary forest of relatively low stature, dominated by Macaranga spp. And other tree

- species. However, steeper areas above 20o, in general, still support intact forests. Vine loads are high and pose a serious impediment to forest regeneration.
- The project area is generally poor habitat for wildlife due to the previous logging operation creating large gaps opening from a broken canopy. Under such conditions, many arboreal animals are now scarce as they have moved away from the project area.
- Based on historical records and studies conducted in FMU 25 by the Wildlife Department, several terrestrial mammal and avian species were identified; the Borneon pygmy elephants, Sambar deer, Borneon yellow muntjac, Bearded pig, Silver-leaf langur, Long-tailed macaque, Borneon gibbons, White-crowned Hornbill, Blyth hawk-eagle, etc.

• The EIA study for Pesona Majukaya was approved by the EPD on 24/06/2019.

Highlights of Assessment

(Major Gaps = 0; Minor Gaps = 6, Observations = 2)

Pesona Majukaya Sdn. Bhd. has complied with the Sabah Legality Standard (SFD-TLAS-002) as no non-compliance was identified during the assessment on 26-30 June 2023.

Summary of status of operations by Principle:

Principle 1.

Pesona Majukaya demonstrated compliance with the SFD regulations. The SFMLA 01/2018 was signed on 20/04/2018, valid for 100 years until 31/12/2117. Coupe permits allowed Pesona Majukaya to conduct forestry activity inside the licensed area for 47 years.

The 10-yr Forest Management Plan (01/01/2021 – 31/12/2030) was approved by the SFD on 09/06/2021 (Ref.#: JPHTN/SFM 800-1/1/40/22).

In 2021, the SFD agreed to consolidate the forest management plan of 4 (four) SFMLA licenses; First Greenworld Sdn. Bhd., Top Quantum Sdn. Bhd., Pesona Majukaya & Zillion Fortune Sdn. Bhd. [Ref.#: JPHTN/SFM 800-1/1/25(JILID,3)20 dated 12/08/2021].

Pesona Majukaya appointed Borneo Agric Forest Services as a consultant to develop the consolidated FMP for the 4 SFMLA areas which is in progress.

December 2022: Gap 001/2022 (minor) - Checklist 1.4.2

No action taken to conduct an assessment and monitoring of wildlife as scheduled for 2022 AWP.

June 2023: Gap 001/2022 (minor) - Outstanding

No evidence of wildlife assessment or monitoring.

December 2022: Gap 002/2022 (minor) - Checklist 1.6.1

CHPP documents for each compartment do not define the stream buffer zone areas to be protected nor identify the areas on the CHPP maps.

June 2023: Gap 002/2022 (minor) - Outstanding

Pesona Majukaya has yet to define the total area and map for the stream buffer zone inside ITP compartments and incorrect scheduling of Compartment 15 as in the ITP for salvage logging.

June 2023: Gap 001/2023 (minor) - Checklist 1.3.2.2

Stratification by Pesona Majukaya does not follow the SFD standard of forest quality stratification.

June 2023: Gap 002/2023 (minor) - Checklist 1.3.2.4

Zoning of NFM areas do not directly relate to inventory data from 6 ITP & 1 NFM compartments for Strata II forest areas.

June 2023: Observation 001-2023 - Checklist 1.3.2.7

The current approved FMP did not outline the Annual Allowable Cut and Sustainable Timber Yield Regulation for the NFM compartment area.

June 2023: Observation 002-2023 - Checklist 1.8.2

Pesona Majukaya has yet to establish the PSP for the NFM management areas.

Principle 2.

Pesona Majukaya demonstrated compliance with the forest operation requirements.

As of the assessment, Pesona Majukaya focused on harvesting inside ITP couped areas. No RIL harvesting has been conducted yet. Transportation of royalty-paid logs is covered by valid Removal Passes and Timber Disposal Permits.

December 2022: Observation 001-2022 - Checklist 2.2.7

Incorrect Sabah TLAS CC number on the sampled Removal Passes.

June 2023: Observation 001-2022 (Addressed)

The Sabah TLAS CC number is correctly recorded on the Removal Passes.

December 2021: Observation 002-2021 - Checklist 2.3.7

Forest Fire Management Plan has yet to be developed and submitted to the SFD for approval.

December 2022: Observation 002-2021 (Outstanding)

Pesona Majukaya has yet to develop the Forest Fire Management Plan as there is a proposal submitted to SFD to develop a combined FFMP with associated concessions in FMU 25 (Zillion Fortune, Top Quantum and First Greenworld).

June 2023: Gap 003/2023 (Raised to minor) - Checklist 2.3.7

No progress has been made by Pesona Majukaya in developing the Forest Fire Management Plan.

Principle 3.

Pesona Majukaya has maintained the logs royalty payment and other statutory charges.

June 2023: 004/2023 (minor) - Checklist 3.1.1

Renewal of Occupational Permit JP(SER)OP 03/2022 has been submitted to SFD for approval before proceeding with payment.

Principle 4.

Not applicable - Based on the EIA and FMP, no villages within and adjacent to the SFMLA area. The nearest settlement was located 50km away from the licensed area.

Gap 002/2023 (minor) – Checklist 1.3.2.4: Zoning of NFM areas should directly relate to inventory data from 6 ITP & 1 NFM compartments for Strata II forest areas.

Gap 003/2023 (Raised to minor) – Checklist 2.3.7: Pesona Majukaya shall develop the FFMP for the licensed area as in SFMLA requirements.

Gap 004/2023 - Checklist 3.1.1: SFD shall expedite the approval process.

Observation 001-2023 – Checklist 1.3.2.7: Pesona Majukaya shall revise the current FMP to include the estimated Annual Allowable Cut and the Sustainable Timber Yield Regulation for the planned NFM area.

Observation 002-2023 – Checklist 1.8.2: Pesona Majukaya shall establish the PSP for NFM management areas.

The next annual surveillance audit will be scheduled for June 2024.
