#### Terms of Assessment

The scope of the evaluation is to verify compliance of the Rajang Plywood (Sabah) Sdn. Bhd. to the criteria within the Sabah Timber Legality Assurance System (TLAS) Principle 5 - Mill Operations and Principle 6 - Trade and Customs standards. Compliance is defined when the organization demonstrates that there is no non-compliance to any applicable criteria. Non-compliance to the Sabah Legality Standard occurs when the organization does not comply with 1 or more criteria. Non-compliance must be formally addressed prior to certification or within 2 months following a surveillance assessment.

#### **Limitations of Assessment**

The information presented in this report is based on documentation and other information presented by the client and observations made during the field verification under the assessment. Auditor's reporting of information presented by the client are taken as accurate, unless evaluated differently through the observations made during the assessment. All information presented in the report is accurate and complete to the best of knowledge of GFS.

#### Background Information:

Rajang Plywood (Sabah) Sdn. Bhd. [Rajang Plywood (Sabah)] is registered in Kuching, Malaysia, with registration # 487766-H. Rajang Plywood (Sabah) is a wholly owned subsidiary of Eksons Corporation Berhad. Rajang Plywood Sawmill Sdn. Bhd. Is a related company in Sibu, Sarawak, established in 1992 to manufacture plywood.

Rajang Plywood (Sabah) produces plywood for the local market and export to Mexico, Thailand and Peninsular Malaysia. Rajang Plywood (Sabah) is associated with a biomass power plant, Ekson Biomas Sdn. Bhd., which located alongside the mill. Waste wood from the plywood mill is utilized as firewood to generate electricity supply within the mill.

The previous assessment was conducted in November 2021 that resulted in 1 gap(s) and 3 observation(s) (Report #: GFSSBH 004-271).

Rajang Plywood (Sabah) does not engage other companies as their subcontractors to provide or manufacture products.

Gap 001/2022 (Minor) – Checklist 5.2.4: The company shall revise the current COC to define the identification of batch number and Sabah TLAS status for veneer arrival and to include reference of Purchase Order to define Sabah TLAS for raw material (or products) purchased from Sabah TLAS suppliers.

Gap 002/2022 (Minor) – Checklist 6.1.2: The company shall reference the Sabah TLAS status in the invoice as per the CoC procedure.

The next surveillance visit is scheduled for November 2023.
