Non-compliance must be formally addressed prior to certification or within 2 months following a surveillance assessment.

Maju Mapan Trading does not engage other companies as their subcontractors to provide sawmilling services or manpower and manufacture products.

Description of the Supply Chain:

From October 2024 to October 2025, Maju Mapan Trading does not purchase raw materials from any suppliers; it only provides sawmilling service to Selera Indah and HD Timur.
