  indicator does not constitute non-compliance to a criterion. A Major Gap to any applicable indicator
  does reflect non-compliance to a criterion. Compliance for a criterion where multiple minor gaps are
  identified in indicators under the criterion may reflect non-compliance to the criterion.
- All issues identified under this standard shall be considered appropriate to the scale and degree of forestry operations undertaken by the parties under the agreement.

## **Summary Information**

## Overview of Licensee:

- Hasil Bumi Makmur Sdn. Bhd. (1219384-D) (Hasil Bumi Makmur) was granted a licensed area of 5,310 ha located within Kalabakan Forest Reserve (partly of FMU 25) by the Sabah State Government under the Sustainable Forest Management License Agreement (SFMLA 03/2018).
- Hasil Bumi Makmur is permitted to carry out the activity of tree harvesting, tree planting, silvicultural treatment, and enrichment planting from 20/04/2018 to 30/06/2059 (50 years).
   Previously, the area was licensed under SFMLA 02/97 to Bugaya Forests Sdn. Bhd. The area was last logged between 1987 and 1997.
- Hasil Bumi Makmur is under the jurisdiction of Serudong District Forestry Office.
- The previous assessment was conducted in March 2022 that resulted in 0 gap(s) and 0 observation(s) (Report #: GFSSBH003-121).

### **Current Operations:**

- No coupe permit has been issued by SFD yet.
- No forest activity as of the assessment. This shall be verified in the next assessment.

• The project area is divided into 12 compartments ranging in size from 246 ha to 622 ha. The average compartment size is 442 ha. NFM: 5 compartments, ITP: 7 Compartments

## **Environmental Context:**

- The SFMLA area is classified as Class II Commercial Forest Reserve reserved for supplying timber and other produce.
- The natural vegetation of the licensed area can be classified into the Lowland Mixed Dipterocarp Forest, Upland Mixed Dipterocarp Forest and Kerangas Forest. In the past, extensive and poor logging practices have reduced the vegetation to a secondary forest dominated by *Macaranga spp.* and other tree species.
- Steeper areas above 25°, in general, still support intact forests. Vine loads, particularly climbing bamboo, are high and seriously impede forest regeneration.
- In general, the current SFMLA area is a poor habitat for wildlife. The current forest structure, such
  as a broken canopy, large gaps and open conditions due to past conventional logging practices,
  resulted in many arboreal animals being scarce as they moved away from the area. Although the
  last logging activities were 15 years ago, the forest structure has yet to recover. Wildlife habitat is
  expected to improve as the forest recovers over time.

- The area is drained by one (1) main river, the Sungai Tambulanan. All rivers and streams within the SFMLA area flow into the main river and then towards the southeast to join Sungai Serudung. The water catchment area is also covered by the main river catchment. The nearest protection area is Mangilan Forest Reserve (Class I). The SFMLA area shared a common boundary with the protection area. Another protection area located 4 km to the north is the Nurod-Urod Forest Reserve (Class VI) and located 20 km northeast is the Maliau Basin Conservation Area (Class I).
- The EIA study was prepared and approved by the EPD (Ref #: ESB/EIA/129/18), dated 06/12/2018.

they are not living nearby.

- The scope of the evaluation is to verify compliance of **Hasil Bumi Makmur Sdn. Bhd.** with the Sustainable Forest Management License Agreement 03/2018 for FMU 25 (partly).
- The assessment is in accordance on the terms of the agreement for the "Sabah Legality Standard Principles 1 4 dated November 2020 (SFD-TLAS-002).
- Site evaluation to verify and report the level of compliance by Hasil Bumi Makmur Sdn. Bhd. and contractors to the standard in respect to each of the criteria within this report.
- Compliance is defined when the auditee demonstrates that the indicators consist of none or only minor gaps against any applicable criteria of the standard. Non-compliance to the Sabah Legality Standard occurs when the auditee does not demonstrate adequate compliance to a criterion.

## Highlights of Assessment

Hasil Bumi Makmur Sdn. Bhd. has complied with the Sabah Legality Standard (SFD-TLAS-002) as no non-compliance was identified during the assessment on 13 – 17 March 2023.

## **Highlights of Assessment**

Hasil Bumi Makmur was granted a licensed area under SFMLA 03/2018 to carry out the harvesting activity from 20/04/2018 to 30/06/2059.

The Environmental Impact Assessment was conducted Ekohandal Sdn. Bhd. and approved by Environment Protection Department (EPD). (JPAS/PP/NBN/600-1/01/3/65 (6); dated 18/10/2018)

A 10-year Management Plan was developed and approved by the Chief Conservator of Forest on 21/04/2021. The 2023 Annual Work Plan has been developed and submitted to SFD for approval.

Schedules for salvage logging and planation development listed in the PDP start in 2021 that do not reflect the current status of activities.

## March 2023: Gap 001/2023 (Minor) Checklist 1.6.1

The planned harvesting and planting schedules in the FMP/PDP have not been revised to reflect current activities.

Inventory data was collected for ITP compartments C3, C4, C7 and NFM compartment C11. The analysis did not adequately define the current forest quality strata within ITP zoned areas to justify conversion based on SFMLA conditions, separately from NFM areas.

#### March 2023: Observation 002-2023 - Checklist 1.8.1

The inventory data was not analysed to reflect the quality status between ITP and NFM zoned Compartments.

### Principle 2.

As of the assessment, Hasil Bumi Makmur has yet started forest operations or hired forest workers. Moreover, the main access road inside the licensed area has yet to be developed.

#### March 2023: Observation 003-2023 - Checklist 2.3.7

Hasil Bumi Makmur is in the process of developing the Forest Fire Management Plan (FFMP).

### Principle 3.

Hasil Bumi Makmur has no Occupational Permit and heavy machinery as of the assessment.

#### Principle 4.

**Not applicable** - No village depends on the concession area as it is located over 10 km from the SFMLA boundary.

**Observation 002-2023 – Checklist 1.8.1:** The inventory data needs to be analysed to reflect the forest quality status between ITP and NFM zoned Compartments.

**Observation 003-2023 – Checklist 2.3.7:** Hasil Bumi Makmur shall develop Forest Fire Management Plan (FFMP) and submit it to SFD for approval.

The next annual surveillance audit will be scheduled for March 2024.
