Terms of Assessment

The scope of the evaluation is to verify compliance of Akil Jutamas Sdn. Bhd. to the criteria within the Sabah Timber Legality Assurance System (TLAS) Principle 5 - Mill Operations and Principle 6 - Trade and Customs standards. Compliance is defined when the organization demonstrates that there is no noncompliance to any applicable criteria. Non-compliance to the Sabah Legality Standard occurs when the organization does not comply with 1 or more criteria. Non-compliance must be formally addressed prior to certification or within 2 months following a surveillance assessment.

Limitations of Assessment

The information presented in this report is based on documentation and other information presented by the client and observations made during the field verification under the assessment. Auditor's reporting of information presented by the client are taken as accurate, unless evaluated differently through the observations made during the assessment. All information presented in the report is accurate and complete to the best of knowledge of GFS.

Background Information:

Akil Jutamas Sdn. Bhd. (Akil Jutamas) is registered in Sabah, Malaysia, with the registration # 795494-U. Akil Jutamas produces sawn timber and moulding for local market and export to Taiwan and provides sawmilling and kiln dry services.

The previous assessment was conducted in January 2023 that resulted in 2 gap(s) and 2 observation(s) (Report #: GFSSBH 004-445).

Akil Jutamas does not engage any company as their subcontractors to provide sawmilling services or manpower and manufacturing products.

Gap 001/2023 (minor) – Checklist 5.1.1: The SFD shall expedite the license approval for the kiln dry plant to proceed with payment. Akil Jutamas should submit the license renewal 3 months before the expiry date.

Observation 003-2023 - Checklist 5.3.1: Akil Jutamas shall register all workers under COI as required.

The next surveillance visit is scheduled for December 2024.
