Makeson's mill license is leased to Borneo Build & Supply Sdn. Bhd. (715981-W) (Borneo Build & Supply), Borneo Benar Sdn. Bhd. (488524-D) (Borneo Benar) to produce mouldings and WVT Timber Industries Sdn. Bhd. (1225533-T) (WVT Timber Industries) to produce sawn timber.

The previous assessment was conducted in May 2021 that resulted in 2 gap(s) and 0 observation(s) (Report #: GFSSBH 004-186).
