OBJECTIVES:

- The objective of this checklist is to verify compliance to the Criteria listed in the Sabah Legality Standard as defined by Principles 1 4 for Sabah dated November 2020 (SFD-TLAS-002).
- Compliance is defined when all applicable criteria are observed to be compliant. A Minor Gap to any indicator does not constitute non-compliance to a criterion. A Major Gap to any applicable indicator does reflect non-compliance to a criterion. Compliance for a criterion where multiple minor gaps are identified in indicators under the criterion may reflect non-compliance to the criterion.
- All issues identified under this standard shall be considered appropriate to the scale and degree of forestry operations undertaken by the parties under the agreement.

Summary Information

Overview of Licensee:

- In 2023, Ang Hong Swee appointed JS Emeralds Sdn. Bhd. (JS Emeralds) as the land developer and logging contractor to extract and sell logs inside Native Title (NT) land consisting of fifty-six (56) lots, with a total area of 313.007 ha. The Power of Attorney was given to JS Emeralds on 21/06/2023 and witnessed by the High Court of Sabah and Sarawak (Ref. #: 1128/2016). Based on the contractor, the area will be converted into an oil palm plantation after salvage logging is completed.
- JS Emeralds does not engage any other sub-contractor to conduct forestry activities, such as log harvesting, grading, hauling, boundary marking and royalty payment inside the licensed area.
- The total area for development is 313.007 ha. JS Emeralds started operations in July 2023.
- The area is under the jurisdiction of the Pitas District Forestry Office.

Current Operations:

- As of the October 2023 assessment, the SFD has approved one (1) FIIB permit for 13 lots (77.02 ha).
- Based on records, 292 logs (527.59 m³) have been harvested from the licensed area.

Environmental Context:

- The Form IIB area is located at Kg. Mangkasulap, Sg. Lingkabau, Beluran.
- The nearest forest reserve is Lingkabau Forest Reserve, Class II, located approximately 8km from the licensed area.
- Based on the field visit, the area's topography is relatively hilly and has undulating terrain.
- Based on the production record, the area predominantly has mixed lowland dipterocarp species.
- For areas of 100 ha or more but less than 500 ha, the landowner shall have a Proposed Mitigation Measure report (PMM) developed by a qualified environmental consultant and approved by the Director of EPD. As of the assessment, PMM has yet to be developed for Ang Hong Swee area.

Social Context:

- There is no settlement identified within the project area. The nearest settlement is Kg. Mangkasulap and Kg. Mantub and located approximately within a radius of 1 km from the project area.
- There is no other Native Customary Right (NCR) claim area inside the titled land.

Scope of Assessment

- The scope of the evaluation is to verify compliance of Ang Hong Swee (JS Emeralds Sdn. Bhd.) with the Form IIB permit #: JPHTN(FIIB)DPS-2023/02.
- The assessment is in accordance on the terms of the agreement for the "Sabah Legality Standard Principles 1 4 dated November 2020 (SFD-TLAS-002).
- Site evaluation to verify and report the level of compliance by Ang Hong Swee and JS Emeralds Sdn. Bhd. to the standard in respect to each of the criteria within this report.
- Compliance is defined when the auditee demonstrates that the indicators consist of none or only minor gaps against any applicable criteria of the standard. Non-compliance to the Sabah Legality Standard occurs when the auditee does not demonstrate adequate compliance to a criterion.

Ang Hong Swee (JS Emeralds Sdn. Bhd.) has not complied with the Sabah Legality Standard **(SFD-TLAS-002)** as non-compliance was identified under Criteria 1.2 & 2.1 during the assessment on 30 October – 03 November 2023.

Swee & JS Emeralds have yet to act in addressing the Major Gaps. Thus, Major gaps remain outstanding.

Recommendations

Ang Hong Swee (JS Emeralds Sdn. Bhd.) has not demonstrated compliance with the Sabah Legality Standard (SFD-TLAS-002) as non-compliance was identified under Criteria 1.2 & 2.1 and is NOT eligible to receive a GFS Statement of Compliance or a Sabah TLAS Compliance Certificate from SFD.

The Major Gap shall be addressed within two months by **January 2024**.

Gap 001/2023 (Major) Outstanding – Checklist 1.2.2: Ang Hong Swee shall develop a Proposal Mitigation Measures for the project area and submit it to the EPD.

Gap 002/2023 (Major) Outstanding – Checklist 1.2.3, 2.1.11: ECR monitoring reports shall be developed and submitted to the EPD to convert the 313.007 ha to agricultural land use. JS Emeralds shall maintain cleanliness, establish a dumping pit for a proper waste disposal.

Gap(s)/Observation(s) identified in this assessment should be addressed before the next surveillance visit. Action required to close the gap(s)/observation(s) include:

Gap 003/2023 (minor) – Checklist 2.1.7: JS Emeralds shall renew the Property hammer Mark before the expiry date.

Gap 004/2023 (minor) – Checklist 2.3.2, 2.3.7: JS Emeralds shall conduct safety and fire training prior to the logging operations and provide first aid kits and fire extinguishers at the campsite compound.

The next annual surveillance audit will be scheduled for November 2024.
