Sabah Softwoods Berhad is registered in Kota Kinabalu, Malaysia, with registration # 16887-D. Sabah Softwoods Berhad has two (2) mills, a sawmill and a chip mill. Currently, only the chip mill is in operation. The sawmill production ceased since 2014.

Sabah Softwoods Berhad has an FSC license FSC-C104743 (SGSHK-COC-008500) from 02/03/2021 to 01/03/2026. Sabah Softwoods Berhad exports woodchip to Indonesia and Japan, and plantation logs were exported to Sarawak.

The previous assessment was conducted in October 2022 that resulted in 0 gap(s) and 0 observation(s) (Report #: GFSSBH 004-418).
