OBJECTIVES:

- The objective of this checklist is to verify compliance to the Criteria listed in the Sabah Legality Standard as defined by Principles 1 4 for Sabah dated 01st January 2015 (**SFD-TLAS-002**).
- Compliance is defined when all applicable criteria are observed to be compliant. A Minor Gap to any indicator does not constitute non-compliance to a criterion. A Major Gap to any applicable indicator does reflect non-compliance to a criterion. Compliance for a criterion where multiple minor gaps are identified in indicators under the criterion may reflect non-compliance to the criterion.
- All issues identified under this standard shall be considered appropriate to the scale and degree of forestry operations undertaken by the parties under the agreement.

Summary Information

Overview of Licensee:

- The Sabah State Government, through the Land and Survey Department, has granted Collector As
 Trustee the Field Register #: 154000674 to manage the area. Sentotimber Sdn. Bhd. (Sentotimber)
 was appointed as a contractor to conduct salvage logging and subdivision survey to issue a land
 title (Native Title) to all beneficiaries. Currently, there are 174 beneficiaries associated with the
 area
- Logging operations will be carried out according to the requirements and conditions issued by the SFD. The project area was previously part of Pensiangan Forest Reserve (Class 1) and was excised in 2015. The history of logging activity in the Pensiangan Forest Reserve was managed by the Majlis Ugama Islam Sabah (MUIS) through a Form 1 license in 2013.
- The area is intended to be developed into agricultural production, SFD issued an approval (Ref. #: JPHTN/FRM 700-2/3/132(a)/8 dated 14/01/2021) to harvest the area for 1 year under the Form 1 logging license that will cease on 13/04/2022. In 2022, MUIS renewed its Form 1 license on 02/06/2022 and is valid until 12/04/2023 [Ref. #: JPHTN/NNN700-2/3/127(65)].
- Sentotimber is the appointed contractor to carry out salvage logging and is registered with the SFD [JP(NNN)002/2021(F1)].
- The previous assessment was conducted in November 2021 that resulted in 2 gap(s) and 0 observation(s) (Report #: GFSSBH003-100a).

Environmental Context:

- The project area generally has hilly and undulating terrain formed by the 3 ridges descending from the forest reserves in the southern region. The highest point of the project area is at 850m a.s.l, situated at the southwest corner, whereas the lowest point is at 500m a.s.l, located at the eastern corner and the northern mid-boundary.
- All surface runoff within site will flow between the ridges into the tributaries of Sg. Talangkai that
 are flowing from the forest reserve in the south. The tributaries flow northerly into the main river,
 Sg. Talangkai. A Tagal area of Sg. Talangkai, which is registered under the Sabah Fisheries
 Department, is located 2.5km north at Kg. Layon.
- The project site is mainly covered with mixed dipterocarp forest and undergrowth vegetation and situated between 2 Forest Reserve, namely, Pensiangan Forest Reserve (Class I) and Sg. Tagul Forest Reserve (Class II).
- The EIA recorded 17 fauna species within the vicinity of the licensed area. 3 species were listed under Schedule II. 2 species were listed in Schedule III based on the Sabah Wildlife Department 1997 Schedule.

The EIA was approved by the EPD in August 2020.

- Site evaluation to verify and report the level of compliance by Collector As Trustee (Sentotimber Sdn. Bhd.) and contractors to the standard in respect to each of the criteria within this report.
- Compliance is defined when the auditee demonstrates that the indicators consist of none or only minor gaps against any applicable criteria of the standard. Non-compliance to the Sabah Legality Standard occurs when the auditee does not demonstrate adequate compliance to a criterion.

Highlights of Assessment

Collector As Trustee (Sentotimber Sdn. Bhd.) has complied with the Sabah Legality Standard (**SFD-TLAS-002**) as no non-compliance was identified during the assessment on 07 – 11 November 2022.

Summary of status of operations by **Principle**:

Principle 1.

Sentotimber has demonstrated compliance with the Form 1 license issued by the SFD and the EIA study from the EPD. In addition, the contractor implemented adequate boundary demarcation of the licensed area.

The SFD did not require the submission of the Forest Management Plan and Annual Work Plan for approval.

November 2021: Gap 001/2021 (Minor) – Checklist 1.2.3, 2.1.11 No evidence of an ECR was developed after the approval of EIA.

November 2022: Gap 001/2021 (Minor) – Outstanding – Checklist 1.2.3, 2.1.11 EDP consultant is scheduled to conduct the ECR monitoring in December 2022.

Based on the field visit, the license boundary was observed overgrown with bushes and no signs of 'rentis' for approximately 100 metres along the boundary as required.

November 2022: Observation 001-2022 - Checklist 1.7.1

Highlights of Assessment

Lack of maintenance of the licensed boundary.

Principle 2.

The Form 1 license is based on salvage logging for conversion of the logged over forest to agriculture. Sentotimber is compliant with the timber transportation regulated under the SFD.

November 2021: Gap 004/2021 (Minor) - Checklist 2.3.2, 2.3.7

There is no evidence that the safety and fire control training was given to workers prior to logging operations.

November 2022: Gap 004/2021 (Minor) - Closed

Sentotimber conducted training on safety and fire control for forest workers prior to logging operations in 2022.

Principle 4.
