## **Summary Information**

#### **Overview of Licensee:**

- Kironggu Sawit Sdn. Bhd. (1177022-U) (Kironggu Sawit) was given the Power of Attorney by Lydia Bu Thou & 4 Peserta as a contractor to develop the titled land area into an oil palm plantation.
- Subsequently, Kironggu Sawit appointed Mekar Mulia Sdn. Bhd. (Mekar Mulia) as a subcontractor to conduct salvage logging.
- The total area for development is 14.945 ha, consisting of 5 lots.
- Mekar Mulia has stopped its operation since early November 2022 with only one (1) permit application. Currently, all logs have been transported out to local buyer.
- The area is under the jurisdiction of the Telupid District Forestry Office.

### **Environmental Context:**

- The Form IIB area is located at Ulu Sg. Keramuak, Telupid.
- The nearest forest reserve is Bukit Taviu Forest Reserve, Class I, located approximately 10 km from the licensed area.
- Based on the field visit, the area's topography is hilly and undulating terrain, with significant soil type of clay.
- Based on the production records, the area predominantly has mixed lowland dipterocarp species.
- There is no requirement for EIA or PMM for the licensed area as it is not applicable for areas under 100 ha.

#### Social Context:

- There is no village identified within the licensed area. Land titles have been awarded to Lydia Bu Thou & 4 Peserta as private property.
- The nearest village, Kg. Kironggu is located approximately 10 km from the licensed area.
- There are no NCR claims inside the titled land.

### **Scope of Assessment**

- The scope of the evaluation is to verify compliance of Lydia Bu Thou & 4 Peserta (Kironggu Sawit Sdn. Bhd.) with the Form IIB permit (JPHTN/FRM 700-2/4/1/855/3).
- The assessment is in accordance on the terms of the agreement for the "Sabah Legality Standard Principles 1 4 dated 01st January 2015 (SFD-TLAS-002).
- Site evaluation to verify and report the level of compliance by **Lydia Bu Thou & 4 Peserta** and contractors to the standard in respect to each of the criteria within this report.
- Compliance is defined when the auditee demonstrates that the indicators consist of none or only minor gaps against any applicable criteria of the standard. Non-compliance to the Sabah Legality Standard occurs when the auditee does not demonstrate adequate compliance to a criterion.
