Terms of Assessment

Non-compliance must be formally addressed prior to certification or within 2 months following a surveillance assessment.

(Kilang Papan Pitas) is, on and from 01/06/1989, incorporated under Companies Act 2016, and is registered in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, with registration #: 198901005334 (182639-T). Mekaworld Sdn. Bhd. (Mekaworld) is, on and from 06/05/2014, incorporated under Companies Act 2016, and is registered in Kota Kinabalu, Malaysia, with registration #: 201401016161 (1092247-D).

Mekaworld has a tenancy agreement for sawn timber production with Kilang Papan Pitas and valid until 31/05/2023; however, no new agreement extended. Mekaworld produced sawn timber for the local market only.

Mekaworld does not engage subcontractor to produce, manufacture products or provide manpower.

Gap 002/2024 (minor) – Checklist 5.2.11, 5.2.12: Mekaworld shall identify batch number and Sabah TLAS status for all materials from receiving to WIP and FG as per the CoC procedure.

Observation 001-2024 – Checklist 5.1.3, 5.2.8: Kilang Papan Pitas should record and submit Appendix 7 manual submissions from 2022 to Sep 2023 to the SFD.

Observation 002-2024 – Checklist 5.3.6: Training should include agenda and photo evidence.

The next surveillance visit is scheduled for December 2025.
