### Terms of Assessment

The scope of the evaluation is to verify compliance with Rimbunan Gagah Sdn. Bhd. (Suria Dimaju Sdn. Bhd.) to the criteria within the Sabah Timber Legality Assurance System (TLAS) Principle 5 - Mill Operations and Principle 6 - Trade and Customs standards. Compliance is defined when the organization demonstrates that there is no non-compliance to any applicable criteria. Non-compliance to the Sabah Legality Standard occurs when the organization does not comply with 1 or more criteria. Non-compliance must be formally addressed prior to certification or within 2 months following a surveillance assessment.

### Limitations of Assessment

The information presented in this report is based on documentation and other information presented by the client and observations made during the field verification under the assessment. Auditor's reporting of information presented by the client is taken as accurate unless evaluated differently through the observations made during the assessment. All information presented in the report is accurate and complete to the best knowledge of GFS.

**Background Information:**

Rimbunan Gagah Sdn. Bhd. (Rimbunan Gagah) is, on and from 23/09/2005, incorporated under Companies Act 2016, and is registered in Sandakan, Sabah, Malaysia, with registration #: 200501028558 (710693-M). Rimbunan Gagah has no operations and only leased the sawmill to Suria Dimaju.

Suria Dimaju Sdn. Bhd. (Suria Dimaju) is, on and from 19/09/2012, incorporated under Companies Act 2016, and is registered in Kota Kinabalu, Sabah, Malaysia, with registration #: 201201033056 (1017544-K). Suria Dimaju purchased round logs and produced sawn timber for the local market.

The Tenancy Agreement was made on 01/12/2023 between Rimbunan Gagah (the Landlord) and Suria Dimaju (the Tenant), letting the Demised premises to Suria Dimaju and renewed every two years.

The previous assessment was conducted in April 2025 that resulted in 2 Major gap(s), 2 minor gap(s) and 3 observation(s) (Report #: GFSSBH 004-820a).

**Associated Organizations & Subcontractors:**

Suria Dimaju does not engage subcontractor to produce, manufacture products or provide manpower.

Recommendations
<p><b>Rimbunan Gagah Sdn. Bhd. (Suria Dimaju Sdn. Bhd.)</b> has not demonstrated compliance with the Sabah Principles 5-6 for Chain of Custody as non-compliance was identified under Criterion 5.3 and is NOT recommended to receive a GFS Statement of Compliance or Sabah Timber Legality Assurance System Compliance Certificate (TLAS-CC) from SFD.</p> <p>The Major Gap shall be addressed within two months by <b>June 2026</b>.</p> <p><b>Gap 002/2025 (Major) Outstanding – Checklist 5.3.1, 5.3.2:</b> Suria Dimaju shall register the JTK license to hire foreign workers, foreign workers shall have a valid work permit.</p> <p><b>Gap 003/2025 (Major) Outstanding – Checklist 5.3.5:</b> Suria Dimaju shall register all workers and make EPF and SOCSO contributions for all workers based on statutory requirements.</p> <p>Gap(s)/Observation(s) identified in this assessment should be addressed before the next surveillance visit. Action required to close the gap(s)/observation(s) include:</p> <p><b>Gap 001/2025 (minor) Outstanding – Checklist 5.2.1, 5.2.3, 6.1.1, 6.1.2, 6.1.3, 6.1.4:</b> Suria Dimaju shall ensure the current system for purchasing is according to the CoC procedure.</p> <p><b>Observation 001-2026 – Checklist 5.2.4, 5.2.5:</b> SFD should stamp the Sabah TLAS CC in Removal Passes for suppliers that compliant under Sabah TLAS.</p> <p>The next surveillance visit is scheduled for April 2027.</p>
